

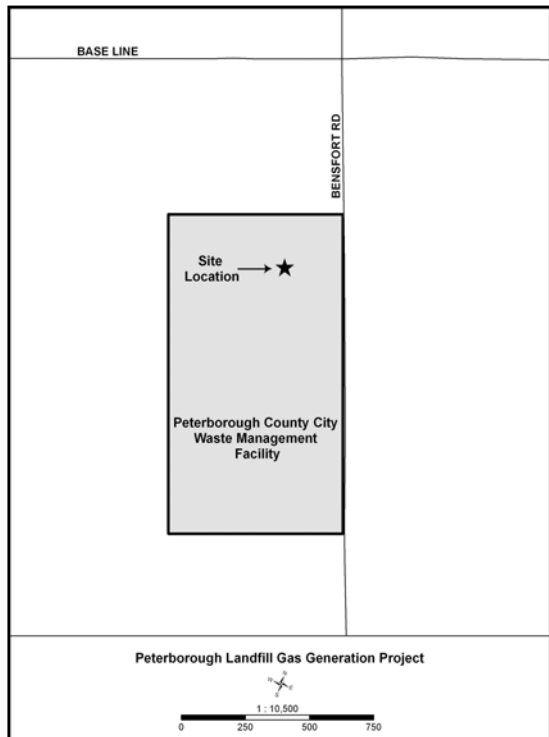


NOTICE OF REA APPLICATION AND EBR POSTING for the Peterborough Landfill Gas (LFG) Generation Project

Project Name: Peterborough Landfill Gas (LFG) Generation Project
Project Location: Twp of Otonabee-South Monaghan, Peterborough County
Dated at: The Township of Otonabee-South Monaghan, this 11th day of January, 2012.

Peterborough Utilities Inc. (PUI) is planning to engage in a renewable energy project which will require the issuance of a renewable energy approval (REA) by the Ministry of the Environment. The proposed Landfill Gas (LFG) Generation Project would be located within an existing landfill at 1310 Bensfort Road in the Township of Otonabee-South Monaghan, Peterborough County.

A proposal for a renewable energy approval in respect of the Peterborough Landfill Gas (LFG) Generation Project has been posted on the environmental registry referred to in section 5 of the *Environmental Bill of Rights, 1993*. Comments in respect of the proposal may be submitted to the Director.



The distribution of this notice as well as the project itself, are subject to the provisions of the *Environmental Protection Act* (Act) Part V.0.1 and *Ontario Regulation 359/09* (Regulation). This notice is being distributed in accordance with subsections 15.2 (1) and (2) of the Regulation after an application for renewable energy approval has been submitted and assessed for completeness by the Ministry of the Environment and has been posted on the EBR for public review.

Project Description:

The proposed Landfill Gas Generation Project is a "biogas facility" and has no specific class rating under the Act and Regulation. The project would consist of two LFG-fueled reciprocating engine generator sets with a combined generating capacity (name plate capacity) of 2.116 MW. The LFG will be collected from the existing landfill and will be supplied to the engines via a collection and delivery pipe network. The facility would also include a flare, gas treatment system, transformer and communications duct/cable. A 27kV distribution line will connect the generators to the existing transmission lines along Bensfort Road.

Draft copies of the REA documents were made available on April 6, 2011 for public review. The final reports, prepared as part of the submission of a renewable energy application to the MOE for this project, have now been posted on the proponent's website: <http://www.pui.ca>.
